

## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

### **1. General Eligibility**

All customers who are directly billed by the City of Oconomowoc Utilities are eligible for having the Utility handle the proper disposal of the unit. Landlords who remove equipment from use in homes with assigned City of Oconomowoc Utility account numbers are also eligible. The appliance must be turned in within the time frame of **April 15, 2010 to September 30, 2010**. Only refrigerators and freezers that are in operating condition are eligible.

### **2. Qualifying Steps**

Complete this form and return as indicated. The Utilities will contact you to set up an appointment for the unit to be inspected and disabled by a representative of the City of Oconomowoc Utilities. The owner of the appliance is then responsible to place the item at the designated point of pick up. The Utility will contact the company approved for the proper disposal of the unit and have the item picked up. The cost of the unit's disposal will be billed directly to the Utility. A customer may turn in no more than two of any one type of an appliance per year.

### **3. Verification**

The City of Oconomowoc Utilities reserves the right to verify operation prior to contracting for the disposal of the unit.

### **4. Changes**

The City of Oconomowoc Utilities reserves the right to change or end this program at any time without notice.
